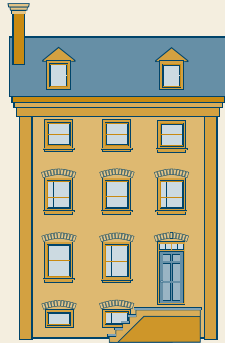

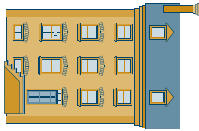

The Historical Society of Kent County, MD, presents its annual *Chestertown House Tour*, spotlighting this historic American community that was once the heart of Colonial America. A National Landmark Historic District, Chestertown offers three centuries of architecture beautifully preserved on the Chesapeake's Eastern Shore.

A dozen properties will be open to ticket holders, including Colonial mansions, Federal period merchant's homes, tradesmen's cottages, charming Victorians, and houses designed for contemporary living in a historic community, while characters from Chestertown's past will welcome visitors along the streets.
